





A summary of the chronology of the stained glass windows can be given briefly as follows: (according to Paul Frankl)

1203-1215: lower series of the choir, except the first bay

1205-1216: clerestory of the chancel

1214-1220: aisles of the nave

1217-1227: clerestory of the nave

1220-1222: first bay of the choir aisles

1214-1220: lower series of the transepts

1217-1240: clerestory of the transepts

Although all these dates are of course only approximate, the relative chronology from east to west in the choir and nave and ending in the transepts is based on the stylistic development from Romanesque to Gothic and is supported by the known dates of several donors. It accords with the history of the building of the cathedral from east to west.
