

## Lubeck



### **Hospice of the Holy Spirit, Lübeck**

Address: Grosse Burgstraße D - 23552 Lübeck

#### Remarks

Built at the end of the 13C, the Hospice of the Holy Spirit stands its three gables flanked by narrow towers on the Koberg . The chapel, a large Gothic hall decorated with paintings from the 13 and 14C, precedes the large hall of the hospice room.



### **St Catherine's Church, Lübeck**

Address: Königstraße D - 23552 Lübeck

#### Remarks

The 14C façade of St Catherine's Church is remarkable for its statues that decorate the lower niches. Take the time to look at the first three sculptures on the left - they are all by the sculptor Ernst Barlach. Inside, note Tintoretto's Resurrection of Lazarus on the right as you go in.



## **Burgtor**

Address: Grosse Burgstraße D - 23552 Lübeck

### Remarks

This gate used to defend the strip of land that was the only route to Lübeck on land. It remains a fine work of military art (13 -15C) with its decorative ordering of bays with crowns.



## **Lübeck Town Hall**

Breite Straße D - 23552 Lübeck

Distance : 0.2 mi

This building stands its elegant, dark and varnished brick construction on a gallery of arcades (1250) in the old town tradition. In front of the north..





### **St Mary's Church, Lübeck**

Address: Fünfhausen D - 23552 Lübeck

#### Remarks

First build as a hall without a transept in 1250, the church was changed during construction. In the style of French cathedrals, the central hall was high (38.5 metres) and held up by flying buttresses. The 125 metre high steeples were completed in 1350. The inside gives a grand perspective. See the Briefkapelle decorated with high lancets in the Gothic style and on the souther tower, the two bells that fell to earth during the 1942 bombings.
